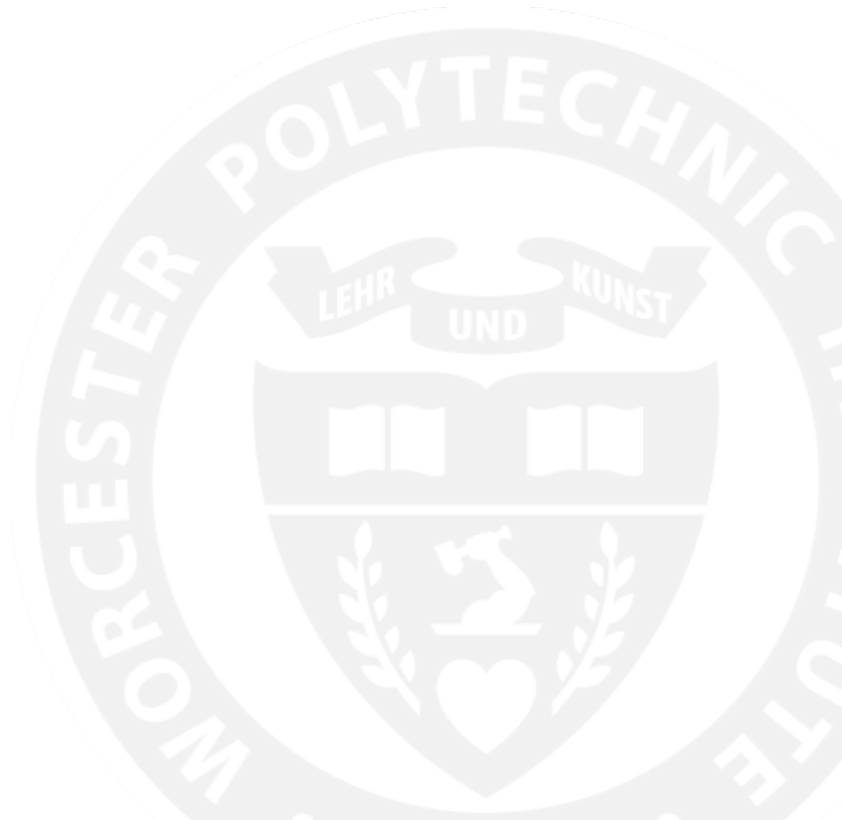

Faculty Early Career Development Program

CAREER is a premier award “in support of early-career faculty who have the potential to serve as academic role models in research and education and to lead advances in the mission of their department or organization.”

Applicants need to show both research and education plans, and how they are integrated.

4% of CAREER awardees are nominated for national PECASE awards.

Deadlines and Eligibility



2018 Deadlines:

- July 18, 2018 – BIO, CISE, EHR
- July 19, 2018 – ENG
- July 20, 2018 – GEO, MPS, SBE

Future Years:

- Third Wed, Thursday, Friday of July

Eligibility Criteria

- Hold a doctoral degree by proposal deadline
- Be untenured and employed in a tenure-track (or tenure-track-equivalent) assistant professor position at an eligible institution as of October 1st following deadline
- Have both research and educational responsibilities at the eligible institution
- Have not previously received a CAREER award
- Have not had more than two CAREER proposals reviewed previously

Variation across Directorate/Division/Program

- Award size
- Expectations for scope of research and education activities vary based on disciplinary community norms
- Merit review: Ad hoc and/or Panel



The administrative piece

- Submit an NOI on our website
- Templates, Sample Budgets, Check lists
- Be aware of formatting requirements
- Get everything but the Project Description done well in advance
- Pre Award Support Team – Lisa, Michelle, Tammy and Orla
- **Try to submit early**
