



### When to Contact Us

- As soon as you identify a foundation as a potential donor
- If you receive a gift of equipment to support your research

### **How We Help**

- Research potential funders; publicize likely funders
- Communicate with foundation officers
- Provide supporting documentation (Board Lists, Audit Statements, etc.)
- Proposal review for compliance and for non-technical editorial assistance
- Coordinate with OSP and other WPI offices
- Track WPI history with foundations

### **OSP Pre-Award Support**

- Proposal development is an iterative, collaborative process



  - Separate programs at major NASA Directorates
- Cross-Federal Recognition
  - PECASE

### **Foundation Opportunities**

- Gift-size will vary; clout will vary
- Utilize the FCP office for institutional knowledge re: funders (i.e. we know which funders WPI tends to have success with; which funders are long-shots, etc.)
